The name of the Central African Republic is derived from the country's geographical location in the central region of Africa and its republican form of government. From 1976 to 1979, the country was known as the Central African Empire.

The currency of the Central African Republic is the CFA franc, which is accepted across the former countries of French West Africa and trades at a fixed rate to the euro.

In 2018, Central African Republic exported \$50.6M worth of services. The top services exported by Central African Republic in 2018 were Miscellaneous business, professional, and technical services (\$21.8M), Personal travel (\$19.9M), Other transport (\$3.57M), Air transport (\$1.65M), and Business travel (\$1.39M).

After Bokassa's fall, the single-party system was maintained, but the name of the party was changed to the Central African Democratic Union (Union D#233;mocratique Centrafricaine--UDC) in 1980. The February 1981 constitution allowed other parties, and five competed in the presidential election of 15 March 1981.
