



## Cost to go completely solar

According to a recent CNET article, the average cost of a five-kilowatt solar panel system is around \$17,823. But that number can go up or down depending on where you live, how big ...

Calculate these nine costs before adding solar panels to your house. Solar panels can cost tens of thousands of dollars upfront, though the money they save you over a period of years may mean they eventually pay for themselves.

Home solar systems typically range from \$6 to \$12 per square foot of living space. The actual cost may vary based on the size and electricity consumption. These estimates are assuming the homeowner claims the 30% ...
