What is Cuba's infrastructure like?

Cuban infrastructure is significant and includes: massive Spanish fortifications built in principal ports (e.g. El Morro castles in Havana (1589) and Santiago; Castillo San Salvador de la Punta; (finished by 1630); La Fuerza (finished 1577); San Carlos de La Caba; the largest in the Americas; El Principe; Atares around Havana Bay).

Cuba already uses a progressive rate, but still subsidizes 89% of residential customers.
