How much electricity does the DR Congo import?

The DR Congo imported 78 million kWh of electricity in 2007. The DR Congo is also an exporter of electric power. In 2003, electric power exports came to 1.3 TWh, with power transmitted to the Republic of Congo and its capital, Brazzaville, as well as to Zambia and South Africa.

How much power does the Democratic Republic of the Congo have?

The Democratic Republic of the Congo has reserves of petroleum, natural gas, coal, and a potential hydroelectric power generating capacity of around 100,000 MW. The Inga Dam on the Congo River has the potential capacity to generate 40,000 to 45,000 MW of electric power, sufficient to supply the electricity needs of the whole Southern Africa region.

How much hydropower does DRC have?

The country is sitting on untapped reserves of hydropower capacity. According to the International Hydropower Association (IHA), the DRC, enriched by the Congo River, holds an exploitable hydropower potential of about 100GW. "However, socio-economic challenges have restricted exploitation to just 3%.
