Is wind energy a cleantech solution for Ireland?

Opportunities for renewables growth will need to be consolidated with issues like mandates for energy efficiency and accommodating for large energy users. We need to ensure that short-term challenges do not restrict opportunities for long-term growth.

Together, these technologies are pivotal in addressing global environmental challenges." Ireland boasts a growing cleantech ecosystem, particularly in renewable energy, with a strong presence in onshore wind, says Stephen Prendiville, sustainable infrastructure leader, Deloitte.

Is Ireland a global leader in cleantech innovation?

Ireland has a significant opportunity to position itself as a global leader in cleantech innovation, in Blanchfield's view. "With a highly educated workforce and a strong legacy of creativity and invention, Ireland is well placed to drive meaningful advancements in the sector," he says.

To support this goal, SSE Renewables is developing the Galway Hydrogen Hub (GH2) project, as part of a seven member consortium. GH2 will position Galway as the home of Ireland's first hydrogen valley, providing green hydrogen for use in transport, industry, and within local communities in the greater Galway region.
