

What is the Falkland Islands Environment Strategy 2021 - 2040?

The Falkland Islands Government is proud to launch its flagship Environment Strategy 2021 - 2040, which recognises the central and universal role that the natural environment plays in the sustainable development of our health and wellbeing, our economy and our nation as a whole.

What is the economic situation in the Falklands?

The Falklands' economy is fairly wealthy and self-sufficient, with 50-60% of GDP coming from a significant fishing industry. International commercial fishing vessels pay for licenses to use the islands' waters, contributing to the economy. However, the islands' small economy is also vulnerable to global market crashes sparked by the pandemic.

Why is the environment important in the Falkland Islands?

The environment is essential for human existence. We rely on our ecosystems to provide us with clean water, air, food and shelter. In the Falkland Islands, the foundations of our livelihoods are reliant on our environment - our key sectors would not exist without our natural resources.

How much electricity does the Falkland Islands use?

The Falkland Islands generates 19,000 MWh of electricity as of 2016 (covering 108% of its annual consumption needs). The Falkland Islands consumed 17,670 MWh of electricity in 2016. The Falkland Islands did not import any electricity in 2016. The Falkland Islands didn't export any electricity in 2016.

What percentage of GDP is spent in the Falkland Islands?

However, government expenditure as a percentage of GDP is lower in the Falkland Islands (25% on average between 2015/16 and 2017/18) than in the UK (37% in 2016), in the UE on average (37% in 2016), and in OECD countries on average (28% in 2015) (source: the World Bank).

What is the growth rate of the Falkland Islands?

Between 2010 and 2019, goods exported by the Falkland Islands grew at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 8.1%. In 2019, exports of goods amounted to £234m, up from £229m in 2018 (+2.2%). exploration campaigns.

The economy of the Falkland Islands, which first involved sealing, whaling and provisioning ships, became heavily dependent on sheep farming from the 1870s to 1980 then diversified and now has income from tourism, commercial fishing, and servicing the fishing industry as well as agriculture.
