According to a statement from Harbour Energy, the Falklands project does have significant resource potential. However, further development of the project is not considered a strategic fit for the company. It is estimated that the Sea Lion project contains resources of over 500 million barrels.

The likely presence of commercial quantities of oil has been known for decades, yet successful development has always seemed improbable. The Islands were too remote, the weather too inhospitable, the cost too high. Now, however, the odds are shortening.

In a statement, the Falkland Islands government said that it supported oil production "provided it is done to the necessary standards". It said it was too early for definitive plans on how oil revenues would be used. "However, the Falkland Islands have significant infrastructure renewal requirements," a spokesman said.
