How much solar irradiation will the Faroe Islands produce in 2021?

At the same time, the plant is the first major photovoltaic system in the Faroe Islands, and although we are only in mid-November and solar irradiation in 2021 is more than 10% below normal levels, with 161,200 kWh it has already produced more than the estimated nominal production.

In fact, if you could find a pool big enough it would float on it. Uranus comes in second as the least dense planet, but instead of floating, Uranus would actually sink in water. This low density has an interesting little tale.

Can you see Uranus without a telescope?

Even though Uranus is 14.5 times as massive as the Earth, you would only experience about 89% the force of gravity if you could stand on its surface. Yes, and without a telescope too. BUT, you will need some nifty binoculars. It is barely bright enough to see with the eyes, but you've got to have very dark skies and know exactly where to look.
