

Saint Pierre and Miquelon adel system

How did Saint-Pierre and Miquelon become a territory?

After the 1958 French constitutional referendum, the territory of Saint-Pierre and Miquelon was asked to choose one of three options: becoming fully integrated with France, becoming a self-governing state within the French Community, or preserving the status of an overseas territory; it decided to remain a territory.

How is Saint Pierre & Miquelon governed?

Citizens Directly Elect Representatives to a Local Autonomous Legislature - As an overseas collectivity of the French Republic, Saint Pierre and Miquelon governs itself through a unicameral territorial council elected by absolute majority vote. This legislative body consists of 19 seats, 15 from Saint Pierre and four from Miquelon.

Does Saint-Pierre and Miquelon have a health care system?

Saint-Pierre and Miquelon's health care system is entirely public and free. In 1994, France and Canada signed an agreement allowing the residents of the archipelago to be treated in St. John's.

Is Saint-Pierre and Miquelon a French enclave?

The archipelago of Saint-Pierre and Miquelon is a French enclave in a Canadian maritime and land space. Its Overseas Country and Territory (OCT) status, its location in the Gulf of Saint Lawrence and its low density make it a territory with very specific issues and characteristics.

Where is Saint Pierre & Miquelon?

A short distance from the Canadian province of Newfoundland and Labrador lies Saint Pierre and Miquelon, an overseas collectivity of France. Its remoteness and obscurity marks it as culturally, economically and demographically distinct from the rest of North America.

What makes Saint Pierre and Miquelon unique?
