Can solar power the Maldives' artificial island of Hulhumale?

Like many small island states already struggling with rising sea levels and violent storms, the Maldives is responding to climate change with bold plans centered around lowered carbon emissions and renewable energies.

Where is first solar based?

First Solar is also constructing a \$1.3bn, 3.5GW facility in Louisiana, which is expected to be commissioned in the second half of 2025. The Alabama facility, along with three operating factories in Ohio, brings the company's domestic nameplate manufacturing capacity to almost 11GW and its global capacity to more than 21GW, once fully ramped.

How many solar panels were installed in New Zealand?

Funded by the New Zealand Aid Programme and realised by PowerSmart and energy consulting firm IT Power Australia, the project involved the installation of 4,032 photovoltaic panels, 392 inverters and 1,344 batteries across the three atolls, and was completed on time and under budget.

How do solar panels work?

The company's proprietary manufacturing process converts sheets of glass into thin-film solar panels. The new facility's solar value chain operates under one roof, covering the transformation from semiconductor to wafer to cell to module.

How big is first solar?

The Alabama facility, along with three operating factories in Ohio, brings the company's domestic nameplate manufacturing capacity to almost 11GW and its global capacity to more than 21GW, once fully ramped. First Solar anticipates having 14GW of annual nameplate capacity in the US and 25GW globally by the end of 2026.
