Where are the Tokelau Islands located?

Formerly known as the Union Islands and officially as the Tokelau Islands until 1976, Tokelau is a group of tropical coral atolls situated in the southern Pacific Ocean. It's a dependent territory of New Zealand, comprising three main atolls: Atafu, Nukunonu, and Fakaofu. These beautiful atolls cover a combined land area of 10 km² (4 sq mi).

Does Tokelau have a capital?

Tokelau does not have a central capital; each atoll has its own administrative centre. The Tokelau group's three coral atolls are Fakaofu (1.5 square miles [4 square km]), Nukunonu (1.8 square miles [4.7 square km]), and Atafu (1.4 square miles [3.6 square km]), arranged in a southeast-to-northwest line.

What is the history of Tokelau?

Key dates in the history of Tokelau: c. 1000AD- Archaeological evidence indicates the atolls of Tokelau - Atafu, Nukunonu and Fakaofu - were settled from Samoa and may have been a key point in migration towards eastern Polynesia. 1765 - Royal Navy Commodore John Byron is the first European to sight Atafu, which he names "Duke of York's Island".

What is 'Faka Tokelau'?

"Faka Tokelau," the Tokelauan way of life, is Polynesian culture at its most untouched, as a result of the atolls' isolation and New Zealand's hands-off administration, according to ethnologist Judith Huntsman.

Is Tokelau a self governing territory?

Tokelau is a non-self-governing territory and is administered by New Zealand. The Administrator of Tokelau is appointed by the New Zealand government and is responsible for supervising the government of the territory. Each atoll operates an FM community radio station, carrying shipping news, weather reports and music.

How many people live in Tokelau?

According to the 2016 Tokelau Census, Tokelau has a de jure usually resident population of 1,499 people. The census shows a 6.2% increase in the de jure usually resident population between 2011 and 2016. The nationals of Tokelau are called Tokelauans, and the major ethnic group is Polynesian; it has no recorded minority groups.

Tokelau has no official capital.

Tokelauans or Tokelauan people are a Polynesian ethnic group native to Tokelau, a Polynesian archipelago in the Pacific Ocean, who share the Tokelauan Polynesian culture, history and language.. The group's home islands are a dependent territory of New Zealand. 77% of Tokelau's population of 1,650 claims Tokelauan ancestry, [1] while 8,676 Tokelauans live in New ...
