Formal electricity services are solely provided by the state-owned Liberia Electricity Corporation, which operates a small grid almost exclusively in the Greater Monrovia District. [1] The vast majority of electric energy services is provided by small privately owned generators. At \$0.54 per kWh, the electricity tariff in Liberia is among the highest in the world.

Liberia then plans to add another 70MW of power through solar PV, which can be accelerated with private sector investment. In July 2024, a memorandum of understanding (MoU) for a World Bank-funded \$16 million regional intervention project was reportedly signed for the construction of the Regional Emergency Solar Power Intervention Project (RESPITE). ...

Post completion of construction, the project got commissioned in 1967.

Construction is underway on Liberia's first utility-scale solar plant. The 20 MW facility is being built in Harrisburg, a district in Montserrado county, at the site of the 88 MW Mount Coffee Hydropower Station. The project has a scheduled completion date of August 2025. It is the first of several planned solar and hydro projects aimed at bolstering Liberia's energy capacity, ...
