Abu Dhabi Airports, along with renewable energy company Masdar, has completed the development of a solar-powered car park at Abu Dhabi International Airport (AUH). With nearly 7,542 solar panels, this three-megawatt (MW) solar photovoltaic (PV) project is said to be the largest solar-powered car park in the region.

The project will be Abu Dhabi's second major PV solar scheme. Solar emirates. In February 2017, the emirate awarded a contract to a consortium led by Japan's Marubeni Corporation and China's Jinko Solar to develop a 1,177MW PV solar IPP at Sweihan, at the time the world's largest single-site solar project.

Abundance Solar Panel Industries to build solar manufacturing plant. In parallel with the manufacturing investment, KEZAD Group has also signed a 50-year land lease agreement with Abundance Solar Panel Industries, another UAE-based company, to establish a 27,000-square-meter solar panel manufacturing plant.

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The 2GW Al Dhafra Solar PV Independent Power Producer (IPP) project is planned to be located approximately 35km from Abu Dhabi city. EWEC said in a statement: "The rigorous procurement process resulted in one of the most cost-competitive tariffs for solar PV energy, set at AED 4.97 fils/kWh (USD 1.35 cents/kWh) on a Levelized cost of electricity (LCOE) basis."
